ROSIE MY WAY three wide in range of a duel inside, came under encouragement nearing the five-sixteenths, rallied to take command nearing the eighth pole, inched away briefly, dug in under threat from a pair in the late stages and held on to prevail. MY DONNA JEAN just off the inside in mid pack initially, shifted to be three to four wide three furlongs out placed to light coaxing, spun five wide into upper stretch set down for the drive, rallied belatedly to threaten late on and just got up for the place on the wire. START IT UP broke out at the start and was corrected then got jostled between foes and squeezed back soon after, chased from just off the inside from afar early on, came under a ride at the three-eighths pole, spun five to six wide at the head of the stretch, offered up late foot to pressure the winner in the late stages but was nosed on the line for the place and forced to settle for the show clear of the rest. GROUP THERAPY three to four wide towards the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, advanced on the front, cornered four wide for home, rallied into prominence a furlong out mildly then couldn't sustain the move flattening out in the late stages. LIZ LEMON bumped at the start when MONONOKE broke inwards, came under hustling and dueled from just off the inside with BELIEVE IN BETTY through the turn, shook away from that foe into upper stretch, got confronted and headed a furlong out and weakened through the final furlong. MONONOKE broke in at the start and tracked the pace along the inside in mid pack, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, offered no response and weakened in the drive. BELIEVE IN BETTY hustled from the start, dueled inside of LIZ LEMON urged along, began to fade in the latter portion of the turn and tired. DOUBLE REVERSE three to four wide towards the rear, got out through the turn to the six path despite a firm near side hold and trailed.
