WITH IMPUNITY, raced close up early while in hand, responded when set down in upper stretch and drew clear late under a drive. BALLY DUFF DANCER quickly showed in front, set the pace and stayed on gamely but could not hold off the winner. HOPE'S AHEAD raced inside and finished well. TALENT TO THE MAX chased the pace and lacked a rally. PORTLAOISE, bumped after the start, raced wide and had no rally. POST PARADE raced wide and had no impact on the outcome. REFLECT THE MUSIC tired after an inside trip. MARFISA raced wide and tired. ASSERT N FUTURE, bumped after the start, tired. JOKESONME chased three wide and stopped.
