KACHEMAK BAY, wrapped up between rivals early on, came wide into the stretch and finished determinedly to be along in time. KING CUGAT, rated along early, circled four wide into the second turn, reached the front in midstretch and stayed on gamely but could not contain the winner. ALDO, rated along outside, raced three wide on both turns and weakened in the final furlong. EL BALLEZANO set the pace along the inside and weakened in the stretch. MANDARIN MARSH raced with the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. ICED TEA WITH LIME, with the pace from the outside, was steadied entering the second turn and lacked a rally. DIXIE RUN raced inside and tired badly.
