PUMPKIN'S PRIDE was outrun early, raced wide, was hard ridden and was along late, driving. SLEWGIANA was outrun early, raced wide and was along for the place award. S S SCRIBBLE was steadied at the start, raced inside and finished well. CANNON IN G was bumped at the start, raced wide and rallied outside. PATRON SILVER raced close up inside, moved through on the rail on the turn, drew clear in deep stretch and faltered. A REAL GEM contested the pace from the outside and tired in the final furlong. BURNT BUSH tired after a half mile. STAR ESCORT chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. CLEAR POUCH contested the pace along the inside and tired. Following a general Stewards' inquiry the result was declared official.
