Footnotes

SHE'S STERLING raced close up along the inside while in hand, rallied inside into the stretch, dug in determinedly and prevailed after a prolonged drive. DIVINE LADY raced with the pace while in hand and dug in gamely along the inside in the stretch. KEEPING WATCH (IRE) was outrun early, rallied four wide approaching the stretch and finished gamely outside. DINAH'S PEARLS was rated along early, put in a run along the inside on the second turn and faded in the final furlong. DOUBLY FORTUNATE was bumped after the start, put in a three wide run on the second turn and tired in the stretch. MONKTON MISS raced inside and had no response when roused. SALON was bumped after the start and tired. REVERENCE set the pace for three quarters and tired.
