EXCHANGING KISSES well placed along the inside, was forced to briefly await racing room approaching the head of the stretch, angled outward after gaining the necessary clearance in the vicinity of the quarter pole, overpowered the leader to take a clear advantage to midstretch, then edged away during the final eighth under good handling. FURTHEST LAND unhurried during the initial half, was fanned three wide into the lane, and came home with good energy to be along in the time for the place. CHOBE rode the rail until being eased to the two path midway on the turn, was steadied momentarily when stuck in traffic as the field turned for home, angled outward at the three-sixteenths pole when a clear lane opened up, displayed a mild rally to secure the show. PRAIRIE BOY raced along the outside and lacked the necessary stretch response. SWEET BAMA BREEZE broke sharply to establish early command, showed the way along the inside until upper stretch, then steadily tired during the stretch drive. HERE COMES CARLIE saved ground and was

no factor. BARTLETTS chased three wide and folded. MANHATTAN STAR was through after going a half. A WILD MINUTE underwent a four wide journey and tired. CROSS THE ATLANTIC broke slowly and was outrun thereafter.
