PRECISION FARMING away well, moved up quickly from the inside under little encouragement to take control, set the pace from along the rail, well rated and under the watchful eye of HATHEER, was let out a notch turning for home, left the furlong grounds still maintaining a clear advantage and held sway, driving. WHISKED AWAY bided her time racing three wide around the turn, was given her cue entering the stretch, cut into the leader's margin during the last eighth, took aim in deep stretch, but couldn't get there. BRIGHT ARRAY tracked the leader from the inside under a good hold and rallied mildly for the show. GRANTED TIGER raced along the outside and lacked the necessary stretch response. STORMY DIXIE within striking distance from the three path approaching the quarter pole, remained on hold, just behind a wall of rivals, rather than swing five to six wide for clearance, was asked for a response after reaching the three-sixteenths pole, but failed to deliver a solid stretch offering. HATHEER was rated prompting the pacesetter until the five-sixteenths pole, steadily tired during the final furlong. PALACE MISTRESS sluggish leaving the starting gate, was hustled to rejoin the pack during the run around the bend, had little left to offer after turning for home. OUTSTANDING HENNY four wide around the turn, gave way.
