SARATOGA SINNER rode the rail during the early going, was eased to the outside coming to the seven-sixteenths pole and immediately asked to pick up the pace, received still stronger encouragement a furlong later, gearing up for the stretch drive, angled three wide into the lane, was tipped out an additional path for optimal racing clearance, took off in earnest, gained readily on the leader, wrested command a few jumps past the sixteenth pole and edged clear under a brisk hand ride. CLEAR FAITH lightly bumped at the start, patiently stalked the leader, ranged up a bit approaching the half mile pole, to be parked just off that foe's hind quarters, sat from there on hold until nearing the head of the stretch, responded well once given his cue, gained a clear advantage after the run through the furlong grounds, yielded late, but held well to secure the place. STEALTH MISSILE tracked the pacesetter from the inside, being coaxed along to keep pace, angled outward in upper stretch and came home willingly en route for the show. KEECHI BULLET placed three wide at the three-eighths pole, lacked the necessary stretch response. FERENTZ raced towards the back of the pack for nearly six furlongs, angled four wide into the lane and rallied mildly. DIAMOND DISTRICT bumped lightly with CLEAR FAITH at the break, went on to take control, was rated along the inside until upper stretch and gave way. ONE STARRY NITE raced along the outside and tired. ZIP TO THE CITY away a bit awkwardly, never reached contention.
