DUKE OF NAPLES away well from the gate, eagerly ran by a reluctant rival to take charge soon after the start, resisting the firm hold being applied by his own rider, acted more kindly nearing the half mile pole, was soon guided over to the inside, spurted away from the competition after being let out a notch, emerged from the furlong grounds with a sizeable advantage and maintained it under active handling. CHERNOBYL'S HERO reached contention with a four wide sweep around the bend, then came home with good courage down the center of the course to take the place. HOT MONEY took the inside route, was forced to remain on hold turning for home, still hugging the rail, but blocked in traffic from the quarter pole to the eighth pole, found room to alter course and displayed good belated foot en route for the show. SIX FLINGS inside on the turn, angled outward for optimal racing clearance coming into the lane and finished with good energy to grab the last major share. CITIFEST saved ground, turned for home with a wall of rivals spread across the course just up ahead, lost ground and momentum awaiting racing clearance, angled outward for freedom in the vicinity of the eighth pole and came home with good interest. LADY RIZZI broke alertly, but appeared to be an uneager leader, was taken back under a snug hold readily the front once the top one drew alongside, tracked that rival from the outside, was called upon in upper stretch but failed to fire. MIGHTY TUFF reserved under a firm hold for nearly a half,

was put to encouragement turning for home, altered course outward in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, but had no serious stretch offering. SLEVIN chased from the outside until upper stretch and folded. MOR CHANCES urged on the turn, failed to gain ground. MUSTANG ISLAND had a three wide pursuit and gave way.
