ARSON SQUAD three wide most of the turn, advanced into contention, gaining readily when the earlier efforts put in by the front runners began to take its toll, swung four wide into the stretch, closed in, wrested command leaving the sixteenth pole and edged clear, driving. OUR EDGE hustled from the starting gate, showed sharp speed while cutting the pace, left the furlong grounds still holding a clear advantage, felt the top one's presence nearing the sixteenth pole, soon yielded but held on with good courage to take the place. EA lagged behind along the rail during the initial stages, was taken outward departing the backstretch, advanced towards the leader, continued the bid from the three path at the three-eighths pole, and displayed a good kick after entering the stretch en route for the show. YA GOTTA HAVE SOUL came in a bit at the break, leaning on GONE STRAY for a few strides, before being pulled off, chased the leader from the outside, closed some of the lengthy early gap along with the rest of the field during the run around the bend, continued to make good progress before flattening out leaving the eighth pole. GONE ASTRAY guided to the rail at the nine-sixteenths pole, lacked the needed response. GOLDEN SPIKES chased from the outside through fast fractions and folded. DISCREET TREASURE raced along the outside and was through after going a half.
