Footnotes

NORTHERN TRIPP bumped hard at the start, was devoid of speed down the backstretch, closed what was once a very lengthy gap into a more manageable one, scurrying into contention taking the inside route under hand urging during the run around bend, was two wide by the quarter pole then angled outward sharply into the seven path soon afterwards, got straightened away and took off after the front runners, was full of run by the eighth pole flying down the outside of the course, lost none of that momentum once past the furlong grounds, overhauling the runner up in deep stretch to get up. HERE COMES DRZ got bumped solidly at the start, from pressure initiated by an errant KING KEENE, settled along the inside, was moving a bit too well coming to the midway point on the turn, got forced to check after nearing running up on the spent ALAINA'S SECRET's heels, went an additional couple of jumps or

so then found room to ease into the two path in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, got fanned outward slightly and issued a challenge for command as the widest of three front runners, was driven to the lead during the ensuing furlong, felt the winner's presence by the late stages, and although moving well got run down by a rival moving along with much better speed. BACK ROOM DEAL was the last and least rival affected by the bumping and crowding caused by KING KEENE, was guided over to the rail making his way down the backstretch, got taken in hand, forced to pause by the out of gas early pacesetter slightly more halfway around the turn, followed the runner up by likewise angling outward in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, mustered up a mild response after entering the stretch, failed to keep up with the top pair in the final furlong then just on for the show. TRAININGFORSUCCESS raced three wide on the turn, flattened out in the last eighth. SIDE PARTY RALPH near the three path and put to some hand urging, closed in on the loose leader, made a successful challenge past the three-eighths pole but had no sooner down so when confronted by KING KEENE, was sent over to the rail and cut the corner into the lane, under heavy pressure from both the aforementioned opponent as well as the second place finisher, yielded during the run through the furlong grounds, stayed into contention for a little while longer before backing away. RUNNING MADE EASY already under the whip spinning six wide into the stretch, mainly improved position. DERVISH PRINCE was under some early hand urging chasing the leader from off the inside, was forced to steady from between rivals, getting shuffled back for a sixteenth commencing from the five-sixteenths pole, came five wide into upper stretch, failed to muster up a solid closing punch. SEARCH ENGINE bumped soundly from between rivals at the start, was outrun for the opening half, got angled outward to be five wide by the three-sixteenths pole, made no impact. GO FOR TWO off the inside, paused in hand for a solitary stride late on the turn, was no factor. KING KEENE ducked inward sharply, causing some crowding and bumping that significantly affected himself and the three rivals breaking to the left, advanced into contention leaving the backstretch, vied from between foes approaching the quarter pole, flattened out before arriving at the furlong marker. GODRIC in the four path departing the backstretch, tired. With the starting gate positioned well off the inside, ALAINA'S SECRET was angled over sharply to the rail, sped off, had the advantage rapidly cut down in size soon after entering the turn, got overwhelmed shortly after going a half, created some traffic situations once relieved of the front and wilted.
