JOKING came outward slightly just after the start, bumping lightly with the nearest opponent as a result, saved ground in the initial stages, but was three wide and already under encouragement for the commencement of the stretch drive, drifted outward slightly making his way through the furlong grounds, poked a head down in front at the eighth pole and edged away. DISTORTED DREAM took up the chase on the leader from off the inside, ranged up to latch on to that opponent turning for home, was given two left handed shots and drifted out substantially from each one in upper stretch, was on nearly terms with the top one with an eighth to go, gradually fell back thereafter and had to settle for being second best. ROCKIN BOOGIE grabbed the advantage in the opening stages, sped along from the rail, pilot atop with a good to firm grip on the reins until the vicinity of the quarter pole, came under pressure for the initial time at that station as the runner up drew abreast and was soon let out in response, relinquished before completing the next furlong and steadily tired. RISKY ASSET bumped a short distance out of the starting gate, was no factor. ROMOLO'S FRIAR lightly sandwiched between opponents at the start, was outrun. CROSS GATE in the three path departing the backstretch, folded. BUDDYS AFLEET off a beat slowly, darted over to the rail, saved ground for nearly a half, swung outward to be three wide at the head of the stretch, stayed far back to the end. JULIUS CAESAR raced from off the inside, was through before going a half.
