Footnotes

FLORAL ROMANCE off the inside, tipped outward for the drive home, was brushed by CLARINDA inside the sixteenth pole while in the middle of her rally, fought on with good courage and got the job done. PROMISE ME MORE three wide departing the backstretch, had a good finish down the outside of the course to take the place. COARSEGOLD underwent a three wide journey, challenged in earnest as three-quarters was being completed, forged her way to a slim lead by the end of the run through the furlong ground, but with a tightly-packed group of hot pursuers giving chase, came out, despite some strong right hand stick work being used by the pilot as a countermeasure in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, bumped lightly with ANNA SOPHIA with that contact leading up to some crowding, continued onward willingly for the show award. CLARINDA three wide at the top of the turn, responded positively when given her cue, was between rivals in the midst of a spirited tussle for at least an in-the-money spot, when bumped from both sides with under a sixteenth to go, got squeezed back and failed to kick into her best stride again. ANNA SOPHIA raced three wide on the turn, was still prominently placed and battling from between rivals approaching the sixteenth marker, bumped lightly with a drifting out rival, that being COARSEGOLD, getting squeezed back shortly afterwards, failed to re gain interest in the limited amount of real estate left before reaching the end. SCENARIO ANALYSIS broke alertly and maintained a forward position, contested for the lead while taking the inside route, fell back slightly more into the role of stalker nearing the backstretch, sat under a good hold bidding time during the next quarter, angled outward into the two path, having been put to urging, entering the stretch, made a run to loom a threat with an eighth to go, couldn't sustain it and weakened steadily thereafter. LAPANTALONES FANCE saved ground to upper stretch, lacked the necessary stretch response. MAGMA (GB) sat reserved in the two path for nearly three-quarters, entered the stretch with a wall of rivals a short distance up ahead, failed to

fire when called upon. COSMIC ENERGY strung out four wide making her way along the elbow chute, raced closer to the rail thereafter, disputed the pace from the two path on the turn, yielded to the winner after completing six furlongs and backed away.
