IN FRANK'S HONOR, rated along early, was steadied and shuffled back from between rivals nearing the second turn then rallied wide and finished gamely to be second best. SENOR FIZZ, rated three wide around the first turn, was hustled from the outside on the backstretch, put in a three wide run on the second turn and had nothing left for the drive. IMAGINARY SWORD chased outside and tired. KINGS REASON showed good speed along the hedge while in hand then tired after the opening half mile.
