JAZZ NATION bumped with SMOKE'N COAL shortly after leaving the starting gate, was steadied soon afterwards between rivals, raced greenly during the run around the bend before settling into stride midway, was placed under a firm hold while bidding his time awaiting racing room, responded readily when set down in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, barreled his way past a weakening HOLLYWOOD LEFT, brushing with that rival in the process, continued his advancement forward while being put to more active encouragement, drew along side the leader with a sixteenth to go and overcame that stubborn foe in the late stages. DRIFT KING vied for the lead off the inside, dug in stubbornly when the top one made his presence, before yielding the lead grudgingly in the final strides. HOLLYWOOD LEFT argued the pace while racing three wide, was weakening when brushed by the winner midstretch, continued on with good courage to salvage the show. SMOKE'N COAL bumped shortly after the start, raced within striking distance, had a mild rally after being asked for a response. KAPER LAKE was no factor. AROUND THE CAPE underwent a four wide journey and gave way after a half. EL CHILE DOG was never in the hunt. BLUE BULLET a brief factor, faded.
