KODIAK KOWBOY well placed racing along the outside off the four-way speed fight up front, was fanned five wide into the lane, commenced his rally when given his cue after turning for home, fought his way to a clear advantage by the time he reached the furlong marker, then dug in with tenaciousness to preserve his lead, despite drifting out during the final eighth. ETERNAL STAR reserved three wide, responded well when set down in upper stretch, shrugged off a bump with GOLD TRIPPI midstretch while in the midst of his rally, then continued on with good courage to be a clear second. ROI MAUDIT contested the lead four wide while placed under a firm hold, was finally asked for a response turning for home, gained control shortly after entering the stretch, offered resistance for a few strides when challenged by the top one in the vicinity of the furlong grounds, succumbed and steadily weakened thereafter. MERCHANT MARINE vied for the lead, was put under encouragement during the run around the bend in an attempt to keep pace, backed off nearing the quarter pole. GOLD TRIPPI unhurried during the initial half, came out for racing room after entering the stretch, bumped with ETERNAL STAR, was forced to check to try to get back on a straight course, never threatened thereafter. AQUINO (URU) pressed the pace three wide and faltered. SHOPTON LANE vied for the lead between rivals and gave way. PREMIUM WINE failed to menace off a ground-saving journey.
