LITIGATION RISK dueled between horses to the top of the stretch, shook loose in midstretch and drew away under a vigorous hand ride. ALEX LE GREAT dueled outside the winner into upper stretch and held well for the place. FLY DOWN checked a bit at the start, saved ground for five furlongs and closed late to gain a share. GONNA GET BURNED failed to mount a serious rally. D'ORO DANCER dueled along the rail for five furlongs and gave way. TAGLIONI saved ground to no avail. HEMLO never reached contention.
