### Footnotes

MY SIRE'S FIRE pressed the pace from outside for a half, took charge in upper stretch and drew away under right hand urging. FREUD'S NOTEBOOK was outrun early, rallied along the rail on the turn, checked in traffic along the inside in upper stretch and finished willingly for the place. SILVER TAX set the pace on the rail into upper stretch and weakened. SWEETHEARTS KISS was bumped between horses at the half mile pole, raced between horses to the top of the stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. BELLA UNO steadied in traffic nearing the far turn and failed to threaten thereafter. NOTHING SO RARE raced up close along the rail for a half and tired. DOWNTOWN HOTTIE chased three wide to the turn and lacked a further response. DUGOUT DEPUTY lodged a four wide move to reach contention on the turn and flattened out.
