Footnotes

TWIGAZURI STRAIT strung out three wide on the elbow chute, worked out a tuck along the inside midway down the backstretch, was rated along riding the rail until the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, angled outward in preparation for the stretch run, settled into upper stretch before given his cue, tipped out to be three wide making his way through the furlong grounds, gained the advantage with about a sixteenth remaining and edged away. LURE OF THE SOUTH was unhurried while towards the two path, ducked over to the rail in upper stretch, launched a rally to procure the place. WAGON TRAIN sat within range while racing towards the inside, cut the corner into the lane, was gradually taken outward while proceeding down the course until four wide by the sixteenth pole, lacked the needed response. HIDDEN VOW prompted the pacesetter from the outside, challenged that rival as the field headed for the top of the lane, kept up the pursuit for an additional furlong then weakened. VECTOR circled past rivals to grab the advantage, tucked along the rail by the beginning of the backstretch, proved ratable cutting the pace, accompanied from the outside by HIDDEN VOW, felt that rival's presence coming to the quarter pole, dug in

well before backing away departing the furlong grounds. GRIFFIN ROCK three wide on the far turn, made no serious moves. BR. ALEXANDER left the pocket under encouragement at the five-sixteenths pole, came up empty. IMASPEEDYGUY raced from off the inside, got roused at the three-eighths pole, turned for home three wide and tired. GREAT KAROO bobbed inward taking the first step out of the starting gate, was strung out three wide for most of the way around the elbow chute, remained along the outside and was through after going six furlongs. SILVER SKATES drifted four wide into upper stretch while tiring. LT. KOJAK underwent an inside journey, faded.
