Footnotes

NORMANDY three wide well rated in close range of the front, came under rousing at the three-sixteenths, collared the tiring leader to seize command coming to the final furlong, inched away under a drive kept to task to the end to prevail. BLUE BALLERINA three to four wide in close pursuit of the front, came under encouragement spinning four wide for home, kicked on with good energy unable to match the top one through the final furlong and just held on for the place honors over a late footed rival. SWITCHEROO tracked the pace along the inside, angled off the rail at the five-sixteenths, remained patiently

on hold in behind foes at the quarter pole, had the pack loosen up some as they straightened away, came under a drive at the three-sixteenths, offered up late foot and just missed the place honors late on. MINESHAFT DREAM shied out at the start when IT WAS ALL A DREAM broke outwards, bumped with JUSTCALLMEMONI, was in a bit tight early off the heels of the pace when bumped sideways at the five-eighths pole by JUSTCALLMEMONI who herself was in a bit tight in behind, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, spun four wide into the stretch, offered up a mild kick for the last major share. JUSTCALLMEMONI bumped lightly at the start when MINESHAFT DREAM shied out in turn bumping MILL BASIN MAMA, was in tight off heels in behind the pace when making contact with that same rival in the hindquarters bumping that foe sideways a bit off stride, chased three wide from mid pack, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, passed tired foes in the lane. DATTS DA BOSS hustled from the gate, chased three wide from just off the pace, swung five wide in upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. LOVE THAT KELLY saved ground in mid pack, cut the corner into the stretch roused making mild progress before weakening late on. DANCE WILD towards the rear just off the inside, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, spun three wide at the quarter pole and offered no response. IT WAS ALL A DREAM broke out at the start and was corrected before any contact could be made with her nearest foe, set a solid pace from the two path under some pressure, got let out at the quarter pole, displaced after straightening for home and folded. MY BROWN EYED BABY towards the rear four wide, came under urging midway on the turn, swung five wide for home and tired. DEFERRAL hesitated half a beat at the start, raced three wide towards the rear, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, cornered four wide for home and gave no offer. MILL BASIN MAMA bumped at the start when JUSTCALLMEMONI got bumped from the inside in chain reaction fashion, saved ground towards the rear throughout and never menaced.
