BRICKS AND CLICKS strung out three wide on the chute, remained as wide on the full turn as well, approached the quarter pole having been put to some light hand urging and swung five wide into the stretch, got straightened away and took off in earnest after the front runners ,got hooked up a three-way tussle a couple of jumps past the eighth pole, being the widest member of the threesome, fought his way to the lead for good in the final seventy yards and edged away. BOZIQUE in the three path on the elbow chute, remained as wide until upper stretch, sat within striking distance, ranged up and made a successful bid for command as the third fraction was being set, drifted towards the rail in short order, wasn't able to shake free, vied with vigor inside another pair for the final furlong, yielded to the top one inside the sixteenth pole, then continued onward in a willing manner to finish in a tie for the place. LEMON SONG closed the gap from the two path on the turn after being wider for a good portion of the opening half, was forced to be kept on hold lacking

suitable options from the five-sixteenths pole until near the end of the bend, got angled outward sharply into the stretch, gained ground readily to be on even terms with BOZIQUE for the lead by the eighth pole, fought from between rivals in the final furlong and had to settle for the show. ELUSIVE DESIGN placed five wide at the head of the stretch, rallied. EPHYRA took the inside route, angled outward shortly afterwards after cutting the corner into the lane, came up empty. CONCEALED underwent a three to four wide journey, made no serious moves. MLLE MARGAUX rode the rail, was asked for some run by the three-eighths pole, made no impact. CHICKWALKSINTOABAR set the pace along the inside, succumbed when put to a stern test coming to the quarter pole, remained forwardly placed for another furlong before faltering. FLATTERMEWITHROSES rated in the two path until midway on the turn while prompting the leader, was between rivals spinning into the lane, gave way.
