SHINE AGAIN raced close up early while in hand, advanced four wide nearing the stretch, dug in gamely in the drive and was up in the final yards, driving. DREAM SUPREME flashed good speed from the outside, set the pace, turned back a bid from TUGGER midway on the turn and a bid from KALOOKAN QUEEN nearing the stretch and fought it out gamely to the finish. KALOOKAN QUEEN was steadied at the start, put in a run on the rail approaching the stretch and weakened inside in the final furlong. TUGGER ducked out at the start, showed good speed while in hand, put in a run from the outside on the turn and tired in the stretch. FINDER'S FEE was outrun early, came wide for the drive and lacked a solid finishing kick. WIRED TO FLY chased the pace and tired.
