THAT'S RICH battled a pair of rivals for the lead during the run around the bend, while racing along the inside, shook free nearing the head of the stretch, emerged from the furlong grounds comfortably in front and held sway, driving. BITABAZ contested the pace three wide and finished with good courage to grab the place. GIANT RYAN reserved off the pace fight, displayed a mild rally for the show. GOODBYEANDGOODLUCK unhurried during the opening stages, cut the corner while advancing into contention, continued on to the wire willingly while remaining glued to the rail. SCORCH THE TORCH disputed the pace between rivals until turning for home, backed off. SLEVIN outrun for a half, had a good late finish outside. MYRLANSKI off a beat slowly, was no factor. TOP CAT TOO hustled from the gate, was outsprinted for the early lead, remained forwardly placed until the quarter pole and tired. NO BLOVIATING was outrun. WHITE'S HELP offered little.
