Footnotes

EXCLUSIVE STRIKE well rated along taking the inside route, continued along on the same scenario for nearly three-quarters, picked up interest and slipped to the outside a short distance prior to reaching the quarter pole, was angled three wide under encouragement into the stretch, crossing over in front of SUPER DOC with the rider of that mount steadying off heels at that juncture, split rivals in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole en route to grabbing the lead, kicked clear under good handling to the wire. MR. ENRICO put to light hand urging, patiently tracked the pacesetter from the rail, came home willingly when asked for a response to secure second. GLACIER BAY underwent a three wide journey, was kept under a firm to snug hold until the five-sixteenths pole, came in slightly brushing with PARC DES PRINCES and nudging the aforementioned rival into being placed precariously behind another's heels in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, kept up the pressure for a little while longer before weakening in the late stages. SPICY DUBAI strung out in the three path for the run around the opening bend, tucked closer to the inside upon reaching the backstretch, sat reserved near the back of the pack, swung four wide into the stretch, the widest of all, and rallied with interest to grab the last major check. BOLD VINDICATION off the inside, made up ground during the initial portion of the stretch run but could not sustain the bid. UNBRIDLED HEAT forwardly placed between rivals for the opening six furlongs, had no rally. PARC DES PRINCES (BRZ) gained control soon after the start, cut the pace, from the two path with the rider applying rating tactics, was asked for run as the pressure intensified during the later stages of the run around the far turn, brushed with GLACIER BAY just after entering the stretch, getting carried a bit inward, bobbed having now been positioned just off the winner's heels at that stage of the event, failed to regain his best stride or any real interest thereafter. THEMAMYNHLEGENDE stumbled at the start, and was sluggish early, rode the rail and failed to reach a contending position. SUPER DOC tracked near the two path, was steadied off another rival's heels in the vicinity of the quarter pole, tired. THE VIN MAN had a three wide journey and was through after completing three-quarters.
