Footnotes

COAST OF SANGRIA broke well and grabbed the early advantage, took up residence in the two path, showed the way from there with MISS LIBBY in close attendance one path further to the outside for most of the initial half, had GLYNISTHEMENCE replace the previously mentioned opponent as the main pursuer late on the turn, approached the quarter pole under light hand urging, entered the stretch and then got put to much stronger hand encouragement, had the runner up cut menacingly into the advantage during the last sixteenth, but held on for the decision. FILE GUMBO dropped back after the start, loped along down the backstretch while racing towards the inside, picked up interest upon entering the turn, vacated the rail route only long enough to scoot around a fading MISS BRASS BONANZA before seeking haven there once more, cut the corner into the lane under solid encouragement, made up some ground during the next eighth then altered course to be outside the front runners, settled into her best stride after this last maneuver, closed in with good energy but fell short. GLYNISTHEMENCE reserved from off the inside for over a half, was asked for some run and attempted to increase the pressure on the top one leaving the five-sixteenths marker, wasn't up to the task and flattened out. DESTINATION MOON chased the winner while racing slightly wider than that one on the turn, tired. MISS BRASS BONANZA thrashing about before the initial try to send the field off and running, broke open the gate as a result of this action, was backed out, examined and reloaded, proceeded to come away a half beat slowly, got put to light hand urging and rushed up to sit a loose pocket, was put to a prolonged drive a couple of jumps before arriving at the half mile pole, retreated. MISS LIBBY pressed the issue being three wide for a half, folded.
