Footnotes

HEART OF NEW YORK lumbered out of the starting gate, strode out very greenly in the initial stages, pulled on the bit reacting to the grip being applied by the pilot on the left rein while appearing to be trying to get out proceeding down the elbow chute and for almost halfway down the backstretch as well, entered the turn three wide and acting more professionally, tipped into the four path coming to the five-sixteenths marker and took off with a good display of speed to accelerate past rivals into a contending position a sixteenth later, began the stretch drive five wide, powered up towards the remainder of the front runners and emerged from the eighth pole as the new leader, drew off, crossing the wire under a light hand ride. LIVE LIFE FAST saved ground early, was on the move to the outside leaving the half mile pole, settling into the three path by midpoint, swung outward a second time and challenged for command as the widest of four turning for home, proved no match for the confidently-handled winner, but continued onward willingly to secure second. THE LADY SAYS YES saved ground, vacated the premises only to long enough to steer around RISKY PREDICAMENT, rallied thereafter for the show. ADRIATIC DREAM off the inside, was under a drive taking the three path for entrance into the lane, mustered up a mild kick to take the last major check. AS WELL raced along

the outside, dropped back from the half mile pole, entered the stretch and staged a comeback good enough to out finish more than half the field. CURLIN N TWIRLIN contently tracked the leader while taking the inside route, angled out and bid three wide at the quarter pole, flattened out. J ROSE GAL sat within range for the initial three-quarters, cut the corner looking PLATINUM AND PLUSH in the eye, stayed a prominent factor for almost another furlong then gave way. RISKY PREDICAMENT tucked along the inside, launched a rail run to reach prominence by upper stretch, couldn't sustain it, and tired. PLATINUM AND PLUSH quickly grabbed the advantage, showed the way alternating from between just off the rail to the two path for the initial six furlongs, was in the two path nearing the quarter pole, came under a stern test at that station and readily succumbed. AUNT TIPSYP three wide at the midway point on the turn, folded. SING TO ME chased while racing along the outside, stopped after going five furlongs.
