Footnotes

CONCERT STAGE bumped at the start when ZIPTRONIC veered out, rushed up three to four wide to take command and show the way on the pace, widened away down the backside given some rein to work with, relaxed into the far turn, had the cushion of ground separating him from the remainder of the field evaporate heading to the three-eighths pole, patiently awaited a challenge coming under increased hand urging spinning for home, got roused at the three-sixteenths, was confronted at the eighth pole, dug in stubbornly to repulse the challenge through the final furlong and prevail while drifting steadily outward to the wire. VEILED PROPHET settled in the one and one in reserve tracking, progressed with the field into striking distance at the three-eighths pole, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, confronted the leader in earnest a furlong out, rallied willingly, steadily inching away at the leader while shadowing out the drifting foe through the final eighth but couldn't get by. WAR HOOT tracked the pace inside, came under a drive at the quarter pole, stayed on same pace through the lane, shied in from off sided stick work in the late stages while safe for the show. UNACCOUNTABLE three wide in mid pack, came under urging midway on the turn, swung three to four wide in upper stretch, offered up a mild kick for the last major share. RECHARGED saved ground from mid pack, came under a drive at the quarter pole, offered up a mild bid through the stretch while getting out kicked by the top foursome. FLAMIN' HOT allowed to settle early on after being carried out a path or two at the start when ZIPTRONIC broke out, saved ground towards the rear, came under a ride nearing the quarter pole, swung three wide at that station, offered up late energy through the stretch but failed to make an impact. ZIPTRONIC broke out at the start bumping CONCERT STAGE and creating pressure to push out FLAMIN' HOT one path, settled just off the inside towards the rear, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, cornered four wide in upper stretch and offered no response. FIFTH DISTRICT two to three wide at the rear, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, spun widest of all five wide into the lane and trailed.
