Footnotes

VERBOSITY came away from the starting gate with no apparent mishap, was lightly hand urged for a few strides before settling into the middle of the pack, raced from off the inside, picked up interest prior to spinning into the stretch, angled outward into the three path for the commencement of the stretch run, made up ground readily during the run through the furlong grounds, continued onward with good energy, grabbed away the advantage from a gallant HEAD HEART HOOF in the last few jumps to earn the decision. HEAD HEART HOOF was taken in hand for a stride while directly behind another foe nearing the end of the backstretch, got put into the four path and took it all the way around the bend, was asked for run and challenged for command as the widest of four front runners, outkicked them all during the ensuing furlong to take over, led by one body length with a sixteenth remaining, but with the winner having made his presence, offered good courage to the end, but had to settle for the place. BOMBER BOY sluggish down the backstretch, scurried towards the others on the turn, was already under a drive entering the stretch towards the two path, mustered up strong, but belatedly foot to grab the show award. CROWN THE CHIEF was quickly taken over to the rail, was put to a firm hold racing head to head with CRIBNOTE for a good portion of the way down the backstretch, remained under it until about the five-sixteenths marker, had QUICK MONEY add his own pressure to the pace fight departing the backstretch, with the runner up likewise doing so a short distance from the quarter pole, offered some resistance before yielding to the second place finisher deep into the furlong grounds, then weakened. HEWITTS was coaxed along while stalking the pace combatants on the turn, idled off a wall of four nearing the quarter pole, sought a seam to breach it from upper to midstretch, had none materialize, altered course to the outside a couple of paths, failed to fire after finishing this move. QUICK MONEY three wide, disputed the pace outside two others around the bend, continued the challenge, but from between rivals at the

quarter pole, gave way. NEW YAWKER placed five wide at the head of the stretch, made no impact. MARQUET CAT stumbled at the start, was three wide entering the turn, got angled out to be six wide by the three-eighths pole, made no headway on the front runners. CRIBNOTE good hooked up in an early duel with a well rated CROWN THE CHIEF down the backstretch, continued to vie for command from the two path upon entering the turn, with QUICK MONEY parked outside each of them at that juncture, kept up the pursuit from between rivals until the furlong grounds before backing away.
