**Footnotes**

AVE'S HALO sat reserved in the two path, was angled three wide into the stretch, closed in with good energy, took over past the sixteenth pole and kicked clear. YES IT'S PINK rode the rail until upper stretch, was maneuvered into the four path a sixteenth down the road, came home with good energy to secure second. NECK OF THE MOON disputed the pace from the outside, was outfinished by the top twosome in the late stages. DOUBLE THE ENERGY vied for command from just off the rail, gave in to heavy pressure past the furlong marker. JITNEY took the inside route on the turn, was taken in hand off another's heels in upper stretch, got going in short order, lacked the needed response. RAKIN' GOLD tracked the leader from the inside, vacated the rail turning for home, fought well for the lead during the ensuing furlong then flattened out. STRATEGIC MISSILE briefly along the rail on the backstretch, was back in the two path for the run around the bend, failed to menace. NICE STUFF three wide entering the turn, was four wide exiting it, came up empty. SAICHI

SWEEPIN chased three wide and tired. SHUSH UP under encouragement swinging from the three path into the stretch, gave way.
