SWINGING AT SIRO'S towards the inside, was quickly maneuvered into the two path once BELFAST LAD was taken inside, coming to the nine-sixteenths pole, stalked the aforementioned rival, perched just off that one's flank, continued to bide time under nearing the quarter pole, was asked for run making a bid for the lead, took over a sixteenth later, then drew off under active handling. MOUNT KARAKORUM took up chase from the three path, sat within striking distance from there for nearly a half, was given his cue turning for home, continued on steadily down the lane to secure the place. BELFAST LAD away well, was firmly in front when guided over to the rail at the nine-sixteenths pole, showed the way towards the inside, with the top one just behind in the two path, was set down at the same time as SWINGING AT SIRO'S, offered brief resistance once challenged, readily yielded by the three-sixteenths pole, and steadily tired thereafter. FIERY FOOTWORK took the inside route, while kept on reserve, was asked for a response in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, altered course to continue the pursuit midstretch, but had little to offer for the last furlong. GOTTA GO ROUND raced along the outside and was never a factor. JELLO SHOT off a beat slowly, raced slightly off the inside, was called upon spinning from the two path into the lane, but came up empty. RIZZI'S COMET swung four wide into the stretch and tired.
