FIONA STORM sped off to an open lead down the backstretch, while placed under a good hold, continued to sail along far in front of the competition during the run around the bend, saw the lead begin to dwindle after reaching upper stretch, began to show signs of laboring at the eighth pole, drifted out several paths under strong left handed encouragement but managed to stave off the runner up and preserve the decision. ALYKELA off a beat slowly, was content to lag behind for nearly a half while taking the inside route, began a long march forward, departing the half mile pole, edging her way to the front, while still trying to save ground, angled outward in the three-sixteenths pole, gained significantly on the tiring pacesetter leaving the furlong grounds, but didn't have enough left at the end to go by. BUDDYS DREAM underwent a four wide pursuit and held well enough to secure the show from weak and tired rivals. SKY FEVER saved ground and flattened out. DONNA'S SANDEE chased three wide while positioned between rivals, but failed to fire after being called upon in the stretch. A GIRL NAMED MARIA taken over to the rail at the nine-sixteenths pole, tired. DELTA HOLIDAY urged on the turn, had no gain. REFINERY FIRE between rivals on the turn, was put to a prolonged drive, but steadily tired after completing five furlongs. LILY'S DOLL off the inside, was eased approaching the head of the stretch.
