BELLE OF THE HALL away well from the starting gate, moved up to assume a good forward position, gave chase from the three path during the run around the bend, with the rider attempting to keep something in reserve, took off in earnest after being spinning into the stretch, forged to a slim advantage coming to the eighth pole, then dug in with good determination under busy handling to hold sway. CATCH A THIEF bumped lightly with INDIAN BURN leaving the gate, raced within striking distance along the outside under a good hold for nearly a half, was put to some encouragement nearing the five-sixteenths pole, gearing up for the stretch drive, swung four wide into the lane, closed with good energy down the middle of the strip to garner place honors. KID KATE patiently stalked the leader from the two path, moved when ready to issue a challenge for command at the quarter pole, put up a good fight throughout the stretch but had to settle for the show. WORSHIP THE MOON tracked the front runners from the inside and lacked the necessary stretch response. INDIAN BURN lightly bumped at the start, was never a factor. KARMAGEDDON raced along the outside, was set down in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole but came up empty. TOUCHING BEAUTY lunged at the break, made a quick dash to the rail soon afterwards, saved ground until the quarter pole, angled outward but had no serious stretch offering to give. SHIRLEY SHE CAN was never in contention. MALIBU LEGACY broke running, vied for the lead along the inside until upper stretch and faded.
