FLO'S GREATNESS quickly established control, cut the pace well entrenched in the two path, opened up a comfortable margin during the later stages of the run around the bend, extended it under light urging throughout the stretch drive. EL DREAMER raced at a considerable distance from off the rail, brushed with TRINITY WARRIOR squeezing his way into the four path leaving the midway point on the turn, proved no match for the winner. ROCK SUPERSTAR took the overland route and rallied mildly to secure the show. ALL ZIPPED UP three wide, was put to a prolonged drive and got out finished. KEYALY gradually swing to be six wide by the three-sixteenths pole, went on to improve position past weak and tired rivals. TRINITY WARRIOR four wide

departing the backstretch, was even wider a furlong down the road after losing position at that juncture to the runner up, tired steadily after going a half. CUP OF CEE raced along the outside, was asked for run by the half mile pole, failed to reach contention. HOOK AND LATERAL chased three wide, was put to encouragement by the five-sixteenths pole, but soon backed away. TINTO gave chase from the three ;path, folded. OMMADON'S REIGN cut the corner into the lane, had no offering to render. SAY LANCELOT roe the rail from the nine-sixteenths pole until the top of the stretch, faltered. PRINCE A. T. C. came in a couple of steps leaving the starting gate, showed greenness swerving outward suddenly and sharply after about an eighth of a mile into the race, remained well off the inside thereafter and was outrun.
