ROVER was sluggish during the initial going, racing by his lonesome self, fanned seven wide into upper stretch, placed outside of all the others, charged down the outside of the course and outkicked the field for the decision. STEPHEN'S REVENGE raced from a considerable distance from off the inside, swung extremely wide into the lane, settling into the six path by the three-sixteenths pole, joined up with gang with an eighth to go and blew by all one for place honors. BARNARDS GALAXY broke through the starting gate and flipped off the rider after doing so, was reloaded and proceeded to leapt up awkwardly at the start, appearing to make contact with the gate, sat reserved in midpack from the outside, raced four wide around the full turn, displayed good courage to earn the show. GIANT INDIAN took the inside route, launched a rail rally to loom a threat by the eighth pole, as did probably at least half of the others, flattened out. GOLDEN TORNADO saved ground and was outfinished. OUT OF YOUR MIND strung out three wide on the elbow chute, was given some rein after being under tight restraint and rushed up to confront the early leader, went at head to head with that rival until midlane, fell back slightly at that juncture but came back late to beat that nemesis. STORMY ACRE got hooked up OUT OF YOUR MIND early down the backstretch,

contested the pace on nearly even terms with that foe while racing along the rail, shook free to no avail at the end of the furlong grounds, as the horde closed in, gave way. TYCOON CAT inside, lacked the necessary stretch response. RALLY POINT off the inside, was no factor. EL CORRIENTE raced along the outside, was in the early stages attempting to advance into contention when steadied on the second turn, resumed the march, remained in prominence until the furlong marker then yielded to the throng gathered directly behind. ALL ZIPPED UP three wide on the far turn, folded. TAPITDAR in the three path at the three-eighths pole, tired.
