TEA TIME broke evenly with the runner up, edged away to take command and was sent over the inside, cut the pace while being rated along, under the mildest of hand urging by the pilot to maintain interest, came under intensified pressure a short distance from the quarter pole and got set down for the drive home, dug in with good determination to stave off MISS BEHAVIOUR for the decision. MISS BEHAVIOUR raced heads apart with the winner in the very earliest stages, responded to the snug hold being utilized by the rider and got eased back, tucked along the rail in short order, went on to loosely draft behind the top one until the five-sixteenths marker, slipped off the inside route at that juncture into the two path and was soon called upon, raced latched on to the winner the length of the stretch but couldn't go by. ALPACA FINA departed the backstretch from the two path, was under brisk urging chasing the winner, fell back steadily during the later stages of the run nevertheless, swung three wide into the stretch and made no headway. STORM SWEPT away last after making contact with the left side of the starting gate, got asked for run angling over towards the rail approaching the quarter pole, had no stretch response.
