Footnotes

FINGERS CLOSED contently tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, was let out a notch midway on the second bend and eagerly cut into the gap, got put to put a firm hold momentarily awaiting options prior to cutting the corner into the stretch, had KNACQUE drift enough towards the two path to open things up along the inside route, was given her cue and responded positively, slipped by a pair to poke a head down in front with a furlong remaining, clung with good determination to preserve a slight advantage even while drifting out slightly during the final few strides. JAZIL'S DREAM settled into midpack after the start, was kept on reserve for almost six furlongs, arrived at the five-sixteenths marker under strong encouragement from a couple jumps earlier and angled sharply outward until four wide for the start of drive home, closed in well, came in past the eighth pole, crossing over in front of a weakening STRIKING STYLE leading its pilot to steady, continued onward willingly but had to settle for the place. HIGH HEEL KITTEN rode the rail for a bit more than three-quarters, got swung four wide into the stretch, held on well belatedly to take the show award. KNACQUE quickly took control, cut the pace from the inside, being rated and facing only light resistance for the initial six furlongs, got put to a stern test approaching the three-sixteenths pole, yielded while between rivals a sixteenth later and steadily backed away. SEEKING HER GLORY prompted the pacesetter from the outside, challenged in earnest right after entering the stretch, kept up the fight with vigor until the end of the furlong grounds and weakened. LASSIE'S LANDING shied inward at the start, making light contact with MONSERRAT, raced two wide until near the end of the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, bumping lightly with MEDAGLIAS D'ARGENTO and nudging that rival aside for position, mustered up a mild response after finishing the deed. STRIKING STYLE three wide on both turns, was weakening when steadied after being bothered by the second place finisher past the eighth pole. MEDAGLIA D'ARGENTO three wide for the opening three-quarters, bumped lightly with LASSIE'S LANDING while swinging five to six wide into the stretch, ducked over towards the inside right afterwards and tired. RANGER'S GIRL was never in the hunt. MONSERRAT brushed at the start, acted rankly while wedged between rivals on the first turn, dropped back after the rider checked and was outrun thereafter.
