LAYSH LAYSH LAYSH within range while placed off the inside, was asked for a response swinging into the lane, made little progress during the early portion of the stretch drive, started kicking in leaving the furlong grounds, advanced towards the leader, collared him in deep stretch and edged clear. PETER'S CREEK away in good order, contently tracked the leader from towards the three path, ranged up to make his presence felt by the seven-sixteenths pole, raced on even terms for a couple of strides before being fended off, moved up for another go at the leader coming to the quarter pole, was set down turning for home, dueled with JUST BEN during the ensuing furlong, poked a head in front at the eighth pole, dug in with determination, felt the top one's presence in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, yielded late but continued on with good courage to secure the place. STARFORADAY raced along the outside, was asked for a response coming to the five-sixteenths pole, came into the stretch from the four path and rallied willingly to earn the show. DESERT KEY stalked the front runners, angle three wide into the stretch, was called upon but failed to deliver a solid stretch offering. JUST BEN grabbed control quickly after the start, was put to a snug hold while cutting the pace from the two path, was briefly tested by the runner up leaving the backstretch, shook clear when let out some, came under attack for a second time, nearing the quarter pole, offered good resistance until midstretch, backed off and steadily weakened. PULPIT POINT saved ground until the quarter pole and was always outrun.
