Footnotes

LITTLE DISTORTED got engaged in a duel with SOULSINGING soon after the start, disputed the pace with that opponent from the outside, under a good hold and contrasting with the more energetically handling being used by the pilot of that foe, had just edged away from the nemesis when a charged up REVOLUTIONARY burst boldly on the scene in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, parked out in the three path, had the rider switch to active handling and got set down to a drive, turned for home still locked in battle with second place finisher, shook free leaving the eighth pole, and edged away, kept busy to the end. REVOLUTIONARY was given some motivation near the right shoulder with the stick and advanced to secure a forward position, was put to a drive and bid three wide leaving the midway point on the turn, dueled with the winner until past the furlong marker, began to fall back steadily but continued onward to be clearly second best. MAIN MAN MIKE urged while chasing the pace dispute, angled three wide into the stretch, proved no match. SOULSINGING bobbed inward at the break, argued for control from the rail until the five-sixteenths pole and gave way. BOLD DANCE stumbled badly at the start and was outrun thereafter. ZANE off the inside, was asked for run on the turn but made no headway on the front runners, drifted four wide into the stretch and got geared down shortly after doing so. SECRET BID saved ground and faltered. CIRCLE CITY was checked hard a few jumps after coming out of the gate, stubbornly resisted the strong hold being applied by the rider on the left rein and was heckbent on bearing out and did so proceeding down the backstretch, trailed.
