Footnotes

NOTACATBUTALLAMA three to four wide in mid pack, came out suddenly at the five-eighths bumping HOLY ENDEAVOR at that station, was coaxed along at the seven-sixteenths making a four wide sweep from the three-eighths to the quarter pole to loom boldly at the head of the stretch, confronted the leader set down for the drive nearing the furlong grounds, went head to head briefly before displacing the leader inside the eighth pole, edged clear kept to task to the line to prevail. BERNIE THE JET set the pace from just off the inside, came under urging as a trio stacked up just in behind at the top of the lane, cut the corner at that juncture, fought on holding off his main rival to the eighth pole, got displaced just after that station, fought on to the finish holding well for the place honors. FREDERICKSBURG two to three wide just off the pace, made a three wide move in the turn inside the eventual winner and in tandem with that foe, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, proved unable to stay with the top two through the lane while kicking home willingly clear for the show. SMILING BOB tracked the pace along the inside coming under urging at the half mile pole, cut the corner into the stretch offering up a mild kick before flattening out in the late stages. JAMES JINGLE saved ground towards the rear, got set down at the quarter pole and passed tired foes in the stretch. SCOFIELD attended the pace three wide, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, had to briefly pause in behind rivals at the three-sixteenths, shifted out nearing the eighth pole and weakened in the late stages. ALCOLITE three wide towards the rear, got set down at the five-sixteenths, swung three to four wide for home, tired and made no impact. HALF WILDCAT towards the rear just off the inside, got set down spinning four wide out of the turn, made no late headway. HOLY ENDEAVOR towards the rear four to five wide, got bumped at the five-eighths pole as the eventual winner got a bit erratic, came under a prolonged urging from the half mile pole, offered no response.
