JAGUAR PAW off alertly, assumed the role of stalker, sat patiently perched off the leader's hind quarters while in hand during the initial half mile, gradually moved up when ready to pressure that one, departing the backstretch, raced as a team from that seven-sixteenths pole to the five-sixteenths pole, edged away from a more energetically-handled foe approaching the quarter pole, with the rider still sitting aboard motionless, spurted away from the competition after being straightened away in the lane, now receiving some light encouragement and held safely under a mild hand ride to the finish line. JUST HOLD ON ducked inward at the break, coming into contact with ALHATHAR, continuing moving towards the inside, forcing ARNELL to be taken hold of a few strides later, needed some strong handling from the rider to finally settle into the three path down the backstretch, stalked the front runners from there under a good hold, was asked for a response spinning into the stretch, was unable to keep pace with the top one but came home with good energy to be clearly second best. CINNAMON BEACH tracked the front runners from the inside until the five-sixteenths pole, was angled outward in preparation for the stretch drive, but proved no match for either of the first two place finishers. ALHATHAR bumped at the start, took the inside route until the quarter pole and improved position by mainly weak and tired rivals. LOOK ABOUT was eased off the rail in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole, was coaxed along to keep pace during the run around the bend, displayed no kick after turning for home. SAVANNAH BAY established command soon after the start, appeared comfortable being rated towards the inside, met resistance coming to the seven-sixteenths pole, was lightly urged to keep pace with the challenger, was shaken off nearing the quarter pole and steadily tired thereafter. ARNELL was taken in hand when the runner up crossed over in front soon after the start, raced three wide around the turn and folded.
