FIDDLERS PATRIOT placed under a snug hold leaving the starting gate, entered the turn from the two path, remained on hold, well positioned behind an ongoing speed duel, moved up when ready to issue a challenge for the lead, coming to the quarter pole, responded positively once given his cue, emerged from the furlong grounds with a comfortable advantage and held sway, being kept busy to the end. STORM ON THE MOON unhurried during the initial half, swung five wide into the lane and rallied with good energy down the outside of the course to garner place honors. COZY LION was taken hold of after breaking a bit awkwardly, was reserved in midpack, began to close in on the early speed contestants approaching the top of the stretch, rallied to loom a threat momentarily at the eighth pole, but was outkicked thereafter. PERFECT CASTING outrun for nearly a half, fanned five wide into the lane and rallied mildly to earn the last major share. COMPLIANCE OFFICER four wide at the quarter pole, lacked the needed stretch response. BERRY BERRY BUENO was guided over to the rail at the half mile pole, began to advance into contention from midpoint on the turn, steadied in a bit tight turning for home, flattened out during the last eighth. BROTHER CHA (IRE) dueled well off the inside and gave way. FASTUS CACTUS stumbled at the start, rushed up under his own power towards the front, went on to duel for command, while continuously trying to bear out down the backstretch fighting throughout a strong hold on the left side of the rein being applied by the jockey, was expertly put into the two path in time for the run around the bend, received several shots of the whip right handed coming to the five-sixteenths pole, began backing off soon afterwards, swerved out sharply in upper stretch once the rider released his tight grip on the left rein, did so again in midstretch while steadily tiring.
