Closed Saturday, October 15, 2005 with 25 nominations.





BETTER NOW was outrun early, advanced inside on the turn, rallied four wide nearing the stretch, drew clear inside the eighth pole and was ridden out to the finish. CAPOTE'S CROWN quickly showed in front, set the pace and stayed on along the inside to earn the place prize. WONDER LADY ANNE L chased the pace while between rivals and tired in the final furlong. JINNI raced close up early and had no response when roused. BELLA FORTUNA chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. SWAP FLIPAROO chased the pace along the inside and tired after a half mile. SPARKLING PINK was finished early.
