Footnotes

AMIGA DEL SOL settled into midpack down the backstretch, entered the turn from the four path, was immediately put to light urging, beginning a long march into contention, made up ground on the leader gradually, picked up the pace once set down coming to the five-sixteenths pole, swung four wide into the stretch, was driven to a clear advantage with an eighth to go, then dug in under strong handling to preserve the verdict. EXILED PRINCESS unhurried for nearly a half, came five wide into the lane and displayed a good kick to grab second. THE MULES SISTER raced along the outside, crept towards the front runners under her own power until the five-sixteenths pole, was set down at that point, continued on willingly to the wire en route for the show. BOMBILLA reserved along the inside, angled outward at the five-sixteenths pole, and rallied mildly to take the final last major share. SUDDEN SILVER chased three wide and weakened during the final furlong. DECORATED COURT took the inside route, angled out at the eighth pole and improved position outkicking tiring rivals. DISCO DIVA hustled away from the gate, grabbed command soon after the start, showed the way towards the inside facing only mild

pressure from the closest pursuers, was put to the test turning for home, offering resistance until the eighth pole and steadily tired thereafter. MY LUCKEY PENNEY stumbled at the start, was called upon after entering the stretch but had no serious offering. SPIRITUAL TUNE rode the rail until the quarter pole, angled outward but had little to offer. STRATTON'S GIRL accompanied the pacesetter from the outside until upper stretch and folded. GOOD WILL urged tracking the pacesetter, faltered after going a half. MINDBENDER displayed brief foot and was eased approaching the eighth pole.
