Footnotes

DISARMING brushed with FIGHTEN AWAY at the start, was unhurried during the opening half, angled four wide into the stretch, took off in earnest when asked, wrested command in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and edged clear, driving. CITY VICE patiently prompted the leader from the outside, bid for the lead coming to the five-sixteenths pole, spurred away when let out a notch in upper stretch, yielded at the sixteenth pole, and just reached the wire in time to preserve the place. FIGHTEN AWAY was brushed at the break, remained reserved for nearly a half, fanned wide into the lane, commenced to rally from the six path at the head of the stretch, and charged home with good energy down the outside of the course en route for the show. ONE SPRING STORM stumbled badly about two jumps out of the starting gate, proved more than a handful during the early stages of the races, being rank down the backstretch, acted more kindly nearing the turn, remained reserved until the quarter pole, was called upon and came home well. CHARMED (ARG) forwardly placed, lacked the necessary stretch response. BY LAND OR BY SEA lightly bumped at the start, raced three wide around the turn, and failed to fire when asked turning for home. ALBERTHA THE COOK weakened during the final furlong. CANTSTOPLOVINGSUE was pulled off GLORY IN MOTION after bumping

with that rival at the start, raced rankly while being steadied along, taking the inside route on the turn, had little left to offer after entering the stretch. TASTE three wide most of the way around the turn, tired. DESIRABLE chased three wide and gave way. IRISH GARDEN displayed brief foot. MAGIC QUEEN showed the way along the inside, was challenged nearing the five-sixteenths pole, succumbed and faded.
