**Footnotes**

MORDECAI JONES reserved within range along the outside, was kept on hold awaiting the best option as the field headed for the the quarter pole, chose to angle into the three path coming into the stretch, bumped with EAGER LEADER, eager for the same spot, got going again quickly, was guided to the middle of the course, closed in relentlessly leaving the furlong grounds, and proved best nearing the wire. NURSE DOLCE sat under a good hold, while well placed, off the inside, responded positively when asked for a run entering the stretch, struck the front just past the eighth pole, dug in stubbornly, before reluctantly a couple of strides prior to the end. LOST AT DAWN took the inside route, cut the corner racing into contention and continued on with good energy to grab the show. GOODGOLLYMISSDOLLY was bumped at the start, took control soon afterwards, was rated along the inside while setting the pace, was let loose nearing the quarter pole, battled hard before weakening during the final furlong. GLORY IN MOTION tracked along the inside, and lacked the needed kick. MISS NEPAL outrun for nearly three-quarters, angled six wide into the stretch, had just begun to rally in earnest, when forced outward in response to inside

pressure in upper stretch, got back on stride soon and came home with good courage. SIMPLE WESTERN broke open the gate prior to the start, proceeded to come away in good order, failed to reach a contending position. ZODIAC GIRL sluggish leaving the start, was unhurried during the opening six furlongs, swung wide into the stretch, was forced to check to avoid a rival in upper stretch, and had no serious offering thereafter. JILL THE PILL rated prompting the pacesetter, gave way. CRANBERRY QUEEN bumped at the start, steadied off a rival's heels after turning for home. EAGER LEADER strung out the widest around the elbow chute, gradually worked her way closer to the inside, bided time on the turn, bumped with MORDECAI JONES shooting for the same alleyway in upper stretch, and steadily tired thereafter. MAYA CHARLI four wide at the three-eighths pole was weakening when bothered in upper lane.
