BRIBON (FR) unhurried down the backstretch, began to angle outward after entering the turn, settled into the four path by the seven-sixteenths pole, picked up the pace nearing the quarter pole, drafted behind JERSEY TOWN entering the stretch, tipped a bit wider off that opponent after being straightened away, took off in earnest when put to a drive, forged to the front in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and edged away. JERSEY TOWN broke out a bit at the start, moved up willingly to midpack, swung out into the three path soon after leaving the backstretch, ranged up during the run around the bend, fanned four wide into the stretch, rallied to loom boldly with an eighth to go, battled hard to end, but had to settle for place honors. HALF METAL JACKET slipped off the rail coming to the seven-sixteenths pole, displayed a good kick down the outside of the strip en route for the show. TAHITIAN WARRIOR well placed along the outside, moved up to challenge for the lead, bid between rivals as the field turned for home, remained in the thick of things before backing off a bit in deep stretch. WILDCAT BRIEF angled four wide into the stretch, was taken out a couple of additional paths for the optimal clearance and rallied mildly. TEMECULA CREEK was rated while stalking the leader, moved up to issue a bid for the lead coming to the quarter pole, kept up the pressure until midstretch, appeared to weakening when caught momentarily in traffic in the vicinity of the eighth pole. JACK ON THE ROCKS set the pace inside and gave way. ROARING LION appeared to be uncomfortable while placed under a firm hold along the outside for the opening five furlongs, failed to fire once called upon.
