Footnotes

BLUEGRASS JET within good striking distance along the outside, was asked for some run leaving the three-eighths pole, angled three wide into the lane, took off in earnest, once straightened away, continued with good energy during the last eighth, getting up in the final stride to prevail. COLOSSAL GIFT patiently stalked the pacesetter from the outside during the opening half, moved up with good acceleration departing the backstretch, with SAHARA KING directly to the outside, to challenge for the lead coming to the three-eighths pole, grabbed a narrow edge, spurted clear during the run through the furlong grounds, dug in stubbornly during the final sixteenth, only to get nipped in the last jump. FILM MAKING unhurried for nearly three-quarters, picked up the pace approaching the head of the stretch and came home with a good finish towards the inside to take the show. SAHARA KING made a three wide bid for the lead at the three-eighths pole and held his ground well to the end. UNCLE JOE fought against the bit almost from the get-go, stubbornly trying to resist the rating tactics being applied by the rider, continued to act rank during the most of the run down the backstretch, entered the far turn from the three path, acted more kindly once given some rein while being asked for run, angled three wide into the lane, but could make little headway on the front runners during the final furlong. VOLCANO RUN rated on an open lead, was put to the test by a pair of opponents midway on the second turn and succumbed to the challenge. CAT SWEEP underwent a three to four wide journey and tired. FINANCIER ducked in at the break, and was no menace. DR. KENNEY under a good hold for nearly six furlongs, had no kick after being called upon. NOSTRA AETATE was no factor and was vanned off after the finish. DARK INVADER

saved ground to no avail. ISAAC NEWTON was pulled off CAT SWEEP after coming in a bit at the break, raced three to four wide around both turns and gave way.
