GOLDEN IZZY stalked the pace racing near the inside to the stretch, rallied to the front in upper stretch and quickly went clear, maintained her advantage to the wire under urging. PINK MEOW raced well back early, saved ground while advancing on the turn, finished willingly and easily bested the rest. HI DOLLAR HAUL trailed on the backstretch, saved ground remaining well back on the turn, passed tired rivals through the drive to gain third at the wire. REGAL'S BIG GIRL broke a step slow, rushed up from between rivals to duel for the lead, briefly went clear early on the turn, tired through the lane. PUNTA PUNTA was outrun to the stretch and passed only tired foes. MARGOLD raced close up early, was forced out entering the turn, chased racing four wide on the bend before giving way. MO'S LUCKY CHARM was outrun. FLIP SIDE raced close up early, was forced out entering the turn, remained within range to the stretch before tiring badly. LIBERTY MILL raced close up from the rail early before breaking down entering the turn. MADDIE MILLER duelled for command early before breaking down entering the turn.
