BOLD MERCY showed sharp speed from the outset, drew off as much the best from mid track. DONNIE LEE had no speed to the stretch, angled in through the stretch and rallied for place late. RUN 'N HOP chased winner from well off the rail into the turn but faded in the stretch. BABA BOOEY well placed and never far back from well off the inside but raced evenly in the drive. LI'L DERBY DAY BOY no speed with an inside trip to the turn and only improved position late. SHOTGUN RON never far back from well off the inside throughout and weakened in the drive. LI'L EDDIE dropped back from well off the inside. YOU YETI YET attempting to bolt the entire trip. AL DIABLA was no factor while racing wide.
