Footnotes

BOUNTY HUNTER was in a good stalking position while five wide, rallied into the stretch and split horses, drew off late while fully extended. HOLD THE CHARGE stalked and pressed the pace, rallied on the turn, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. LITTLE LUCK duled for the lead and set the pace, drew clear on the turn and drew off in upper stretch, weakened and began to fade. CLASSY WONDER was well placed while between horses, was steadied entering the turn, gave way and dropped back. SHARP ROMA was unhurried early while six wide, ran evenly with no rally. GREEN N GOLDIE was void of early speed while five wide, had a mild late rally and some late gain. PHIL THE THRILL showed good early speed, faltered and faded. LIL PERFECT STORM failed to menace. NAPOLEON J flashed brief early speed before stopping. DIAMOND ROLL was no factor.
